- ► Since September 2015 OUP launched language dictionary websites for isiZulu, Northern Sotho, Malay, Urdu, Indonesian, Setswana, Romanian, and Latvian
- Forthcoming websites for Hindi and Swahili



Oxford Global Languages (OGL) Vision




- ► Localized websites and digital access for multiple languages

OGL websites powered by APIs






What is an API?



- API stands for Application Programming Interface
- ► A Web API is a set of rules for **exchanging information** with a website
- A Web API is a machine-to-machine interface for receiving and sending data via HTTP requests
- ► APIs are the **digital glue linking apps and services** on the Internet

Benefits of API




- ► **Reusability**: data for different languages are delivered through the same API thus reducing costs
- ► Flexibility: data can be shipped in multiple formats (XML, JSON, JSON-LD, RDF, etc.)
- ► Integration and Automation: external systems, applications, and developers can easily integrate and consume data
